The Y-filer for this DNA profile has obtained a partial result, making it a weak comparison. It may be possible to be compared to that of 1294 (nephew of NP210) DNA.

DSC CLANCY provided 1294 with a summary of the following:

- * it was deemed unreliable to obtain a DNA profile from a keepsake item belonging to NP210 due to the length he has been deceased
- * the DNA process was explained in further detail being police required 1294 s DNA profile however only comparing the Y-filer not his entire DNA profile to this investigation

I294 again declined to provide his DNA sample to police for this investigation. He did not have any further questions about this matter. DSC CLANCY thanked **I294** for his time for this matter.
