About 10.35am on Friday 16/03/2018 DSC CLANCY and HUNGERFORD attended the residence of NP214. He was informed that investigators would like to speak to him about the murder of Kenneth BRENNAN from June 1995.

NP214 invited investigators into his home. NP214 is now 85 years old. He appeared to have a good memory of the events surrounding the long weekend in June 1995, including the death of Kenneth BRANNAN though he could not recall attending Coroner's Court to give evidence at the inquest into the death of BRENNAN on 17/09/1996.

NP214 stated he met BRENNAN and his boyfriend NP215 through a mutual friend (he could not recall this person's name). He remained in phone contact with this mutual friend for a few years after the death of BRENNAN though their friendship eventually drifted apart.

NP214's recollection of the June weekend in 1995 was BRENNAN and NP215 arrived at his home on the Saturday. BRENNAN left sometime during that night. NP215 stayed with him until Monday afternoon. NP214 stated he was living in a one-bedroom unit. He double locked his front door, using a key. Without the key, it was impossible to get in and out of the unit. As NP214 did not know NP215 for a long time he placed this key out of sight of NP215 and is adamant that NP215 could not have left the unit with NP214's knowledge. NP214 reiterates that he was confident NP215 was with him the entire weekend.

NP214 described NP215 as not a bright boy (not dumb), who was not very forceful and had a menial job. It was known that the relationship between BRENNAN and NP215 was almost finished.

After BRENNAN's body was located NP215 spent 2-3 days with NP214 before he moved into another home. According to NP214 he has had no contact with NP215 since this time.

Conversation concluded at 10.45am.
