

Conversation with Dr BRUCE re: clarifying info from report

Brief Description: On Wednesday 18 April 2018 Dr David BRUCE was contacted by DSC CLANCY. The forensic report which was created for this investigation dated 13 January 2017 was discussed in detail (refer to linked product).

It was confirmed that Male 'A' profile is Kenneth BRENNAN. Male 'B' profile was located on the inside front of the YSL green underpants, just below the waistband. A sample was taken from a condom located on the toilet seat which was a mixture of the deceased (Male 'A' profile) and Male 'B' profile. According to Dr BRUCE, at this time there is no further testing which can be conducted on Male 'B' profile.

Male 'B' profile is currently on the National DNA database and will remain there.

Dr BRUCE confirmed all blood samples from nominated suspects which were obtained by the original investigators have been compared to male 'B' profile, with no match.

The suspects nominated from the original investigation were:

Dr BRUCE will complete a further report clarifying the status of the DNA results from FS95/444. It must be noted none of the exhibits from this report are on EFIMS. It is anticipated the report will be available to DSC CLANCY within the next fortnight.
