I have requested an increase in the amplification cycles for two of these samples which may bring up some more information re the unknown DNA profile. We also have the option of using Y - Filer Plus to expand the Y profile. Currently the DNA profiles are not extensive enough for familial searching and I doubt there is enough sample to accommodate molecular phenotyping.
