We refer to your letter 26 September in relation to the death of Kenneth Richard Brennan.

I am instructed as follows (in response to each of the dot points contained in your letter):

Detective Senior Constable Adam Noy (Unsolved Homicide Team) conducted a further review of the exhibits previously identified during the 2016 - 2019 re-investigation. The review included meeting with staff from Forensic Evidence and Technical Services (FETS) on 9 February 2022. The meeting involved a review of all available exhibits. On 31 August 2022 Detective Senior Constable Noy was informed by Sergeant Anne Coady (FETS) that: "In regard to re-examining the actual exhibits, this was done extensively at FASS in the 2018 - 2019 review. So essentially unless there is further investigative information or a focus on a particular exhibit further testing is not likely to yield any further results at this time."

We are informed by the UHT that NP215 (former partner of Kenneth Brennan) has provided a DNA sample which does not match the unmatched DNA profile. Further, we are informed that the unmatched DNA profile is unsuitable for familial DNA testing because it is a partial profile that does not contain the number of ID points required for familial testing.

We are informed by the UHT that It is currently considered that all forensic and investigative opportunities have been explored and are unable to be advanced at this time, including with respect to the examination of exhibits. All Unsolved Homicide Investigations remain open and NSWPF will act on any information that becomes available.
