- 1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything that I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.
- 2. I am 22 years of age.
- 3. On the morning of Sunday the 11th of October 2009 I was at home in Kensignton watching a movie with my boyfriend Michael . We were watching Criminal Minds. While we were watching TV I received a facebook message from my friend 1359 was nearby and he asked me if I was available to catch up. I refer to 359 as 1 saw that message was sent to me at 12.20am but I didn't see the message until 1.40am. I sent 1359 a facebook message with my phone number, saying I was home.
- 4. 1359 called my mobile phone at 2.13am. I know that it was 2.13am because I saw it was that time on my phone records that are kept in my mobile phone. I only have one mobile phone and . When I received this phone call from 1359, I saw the mobile number come up on the display. I previously didn't have [359]'s phone number.
- 5. 1359 told me that he was just around the corner from my house; I said I would get dressed and call him back. I ended the phone call, got dressed, and about 2 or 3 minutes later I called [1359] back. I asked [1359] where he was, and he told me that he was half way to Fox Studios.

Initially I began walking towards Anzac Parade, Kensington towards Moore Park but when I realised he was further than I thought I walked back to my house and I was just pacing out the front of my house because my boyfriend was asleep.

- 6. 1359 told me he was going to walk home, he wouldn't stay the night at our house, so I figured I would talk to him while he walking back to his house. The conversation was just general conversation. As we were talking he was updating me on what area he was in and on what street he was walking on. At one point in the conversation he told me he felt uncomfortable and he made reference to the murder in the area that occurred recently.
- Throughout this conversation 1359 told me was walking up Anzac Parade, and then on Moore
 Park Road towards the Equestrian Centre. The Equestrian Centre was the last location he
 gave me.
- 8. 1359 came across as sounding tipsy, he was talking more than normal, when I say 'normal' I mean when he is sober. I could understand what he was saying, he was clear in his words. I hadn't been drinking alcohol that morning or the night before.
- 9. As 1359 and I were chatting. I heard multiple voices which weren't 1359 is in the background. They were male voices. I couldn't tell if the voices had an accent or not, but they were definitely male. There wouldn't have been more than four voices; there were definitely at least two voices apart from 1359 is that I heard.
- 10. I couldn't hear what was being said; I couldn't hear what 1359 was saying or what the other males were saying. The voices were definitely raised, initially I thought the voices sounded like they were having fun and joking around. I think 1359 solice went up in pitch but I couldn't understand what he was saying. It was this stage I was became very worried and started thinking that something serious was going on. I heard 1359 screaming and within a second after 1359 screamed the phone went dead.
- 11. I called [359]'s phone, the first few times I phoned [359]'s phone, I got a pre-recorded message that said there was no coverage in the area. After that, I got through two or three times in a row, someone picked up and I could hear breathing but no one was saying anything

I was saying " 1359 , are you there. Just tell me where you are and I'll come get you." The first time I got through, the phone call lasted about a minute or two, the second and third times lasted only 20 or 30 seconds. In one of these phone calls I said something like "I'm just going to keep on calling until you let me know what happened."

- 12. I continued to call 1359 's phone number, sometimes it rang, and this happened at least five (5) or six (6) times. I got more messages that said there was no coverage and other times it said it was engaged.
- 13. One of my phone calls someone picked up, I said something like 1359 are you there, are you ok."

A male voice said something like "I just found this phone." And then they hung up.

- 14. This male voice had a strong accent, I think it was Indian or Pakistani, it was a mid low voice. This male had a lower voice than [359], so immediately I knew it wasn't [1359]. I couldn't hear anything in the background. I called back a couple of times, and it rang out or someone had pressed hang up on the phone. I sent a text message at 2.51am and this text message read 'I don't care about the phone just let me know where the guy you got it off is and if he's alright and I'll leave you alone.'
- 15. I kept calling after that, but the phone was switched off. I kept on trying for about 10 minutes, but I kept on getting the message that the phone was switched off.
- 16. About 3.15am I received a phone call from [1359]'s home phone number; answered it and [359] was on the other line.

1359 said "I've gotten home and I've been stabbed."

He sounded very shaken up. I asked for his address and told him I would be over there.

17. I jumped in a cab and went to [359]'s house. By the time I got to [359]'s house there were police vehicles and an Ambulance out the front. I saw that police was speaking to 1359 and Ambulance Officer's were treating his arm.

- 18. I saw that 1359 had a gash about 15 20 centimetres long on his left arm in the upper arm part. The Ambulance Officers were cleaning the wound up, but there was a bit of blood around it.
- 19. I spoke to police and I told them what happened from my perspective and gave them my details. 359 got taken to hospital by the Ambulance Officer and 359 s father gave me a lift home.
- 20. 1359 called me at midday and asked me if I could come into the Surry Hills Police Station and gave a statement. I agreed. 1359 's parents picked me up from my house and 1359, his parents and I arrived at Surry Hills Police Station about 1.45pm.
- 21. About 2.15pm I spoke to Detective DAVIS to Senior Constable THRELFALL and I gave this statement to Senior Constable THRELFALL.
