- 1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I will be liable to prosecution if I have willfully stated in it anything that I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.
- 2. I am 30 years of age.
- On Friday the 16th of October 2009 I provided police with a statement with regards to an incident on Lang Road, Centennial Park. On Tuesday the 20th of October 2009 Plain Clothes Constable JONES contacted me and asked me to clarify some aspects of my statement.
- 4. With respect to paragraph four of my original statement I remember that when I saw the male sitting on the brick wall I noticed he had a dark coloured backpack next to him. I remember that the bottle was clear in appearance and that he was sipping out of it.
- 5. With respect to paragraph six of my original statement I would have walked approximately 300 metres in distance since exiting the Fox Studio Complex. When I noticed the male at this time I know it was the same male I had seen earlier because he was of Black African appearance and was wearing the same clothing. The first time I saw the male I noticed that his hood was down sitting behind his head but this time he was wearing it. The male was still carrying a bottle. When the male grabbed me I was not on the roadway but I was on the footpath area toward the gutter. When he grabbed me I had my handbag on my right shoulder. I immediately pulled harshly away from the male and hit his arms breaking free from the male's grip. When the taxi stopped to pick me up I heard the male run towards the direction of Fox Studios,
