Melanie,

Unfortunately in June 2009 the role was de-established and no bias crime capability existed within the organisation from June 2009 until September 2012. The last bias crime related data is May 2009. A cursory review of the 2009 identified incidents does not indicate any sexual orientation bias crimes activity in the Centennial Park area. It should be noted that there are a number of issues with the data we have, primarily hate crimes are under reported by the community and police especially back then either didn't flag the associated factor to identify it or didn't identify the crime as a hate crime.

Depending on what you are after there are a couple of options;

- 1) We can look at all the data we have from 2007 to 2009 and see if there was any evidence of targeting of the location or similar locations. This is the quickest solution but has the caveat that it will not be very detailed or accurate.
- 2) We can undertake a bias crimes assessment on the location to assess the likelihood of the location being a location where gay bias crimes occurred and/or were likely to occur. Effectively we would review all events for the location and surrounding area for a given time frame to determine if any events were reported and not flagged. We will look at known offenders and see if they were active in the area or were likely to target the location. We will assess the location for suitability for hate crimes based on offender typologies, geography and MO and do a report with our findings. This is naturally more resource intensive and will take longer (time frame is dependant on the time frame selected, the further we go back/forward from the murder, the longer it will take).
- 3) We can conduct an bias crimes assessment on the homicide and give you our opinion on whether it was likely to be a sexual orientation bias crime.
- 4) We can do a combination of the options above.

In relation to the definition of a gay hate murder, from the NSWPF perspective there isn't one. We would assess the homicide in light of its motivation and if we could determine that there was whole or partial bias motivation then we would classify the homicide as a bias crime.

The NSWPF definition of a bias crime is;

A criminal offence committed against persons, associates of persons, property or society that is an offender's bias against an individual's or group's actual or perceived race, religion, ethnic/ na identity, age, disability status, sexual orientation or homelessness status.
