The blood sample (item 1) said to be from Barry
 Richard JONES was group O, PGM 1, Hp 2-1.

Human blood was present on items 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12
 and 14.

Grouping tests were performed on the bloodstained
 items and the following results were obtained:

Semen was detected on the penile swab (item 2) and
 penile smear (item 3). Coincident seminal stains
 were present on the inside front of the underpants
 (item 11) and the inside front of the trousers (item 12).

Grouping of the seminal-stained areas of items 2 and 11 established the presence of group O blood group substances. This finding is consistent with the semen having originated from JONES.

Semen was not detected on the anal swab (item 4) and anal smear (item 5).
