Dear Fingerprints

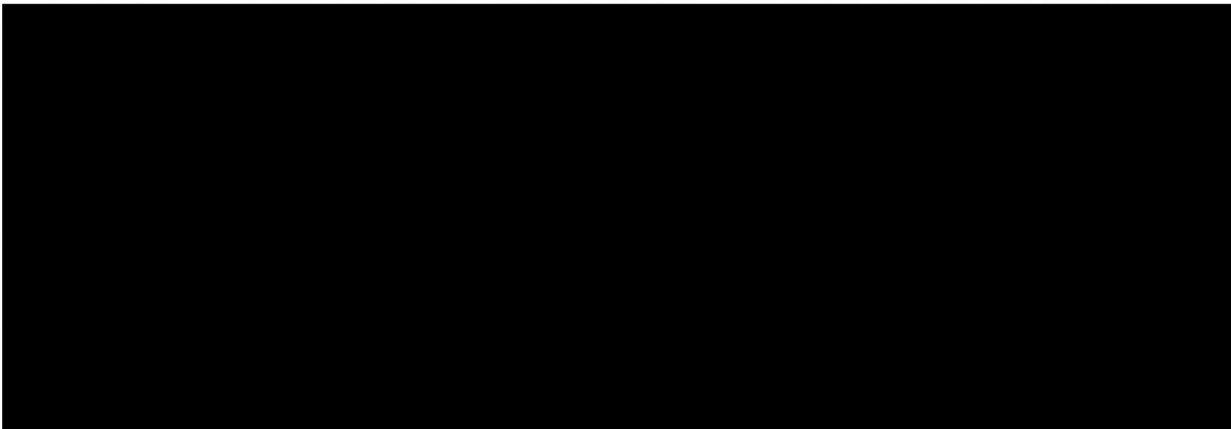
I am requesting that a fingerprint review be conducted on the following 2 cases. Neither is urgent, especially not the Clarke case.

1. Barry JONES, murdered in the grandstand at Five Dock Park on 26/9/1976. Jones was stabbed over 50 times and was a real mess when found the next morning. I have reviewed the brief and there are no real suspects, although it seems that a number of people had elimination prints taken and were eliminated on the basis of not matching the fingerprints found at the crime scene.

The brief does not mention where the prints were found (other than the grandstand) or what type of prints (finger/palm etc) and there are no other details available in what I have reviewed, so I don't know how they came to the conclusion that the fingerprints were those of the offender (were they in blood?) as the grandstand was a public place and I assume the prints could have been left there at any time.

I have a reference in another document as the case being major crime index no. 45 and that there were 4 traceable prints.

I would appreciate it if you could review what you have.
