Details	<p>On the 27/09/1976 Mr Alde ZAJC of [REDACTED], Leichhardt attended the Five Dock Police Station to report a body in the grandstand of Five Dock Park. Police attended and located the body of the deceased, Barry Richard JONES, born 22/05/1935, of [REDACTED] Walker Street, Haberfield. The deceased had suffered multiple stab wounds to the chest, back and neck. The deceased was positively identified to police by his cousin, Kenneth Raymond GRANT. A post mortem examination was carried out on the deceased by Doctor BRIGHTON. The deceased was last seen alive at the Western Suburbs Soccer Club on the evening of the 26/09/1976 about 10.30pm. Further movements were not established after that date. The matter was heard before the coroner and an open finding was handed down in relation to the matter. On the 05/05/1998 a Mr Patrick SYRON of [REDACTED], Drummoyne attended the Five Dock Police Station and stated that he had been at the Drummoyne RSL Club when he was talking about the deceased to a [REDACTED] 1392. [REDACTED] stated that he knew the person who was responsible for the murder, that being a [REDACTED] NP246, 15 old, of [REDACTED] Minnesota Avenue, Five Dock. He further stated that [REDACTED] NP246, not long after the murder, had jumped out of a hospital window and killed himself. After hearing this information and knowing that the murder was unsolved the informant came to police with the information. The Field Information Unit (CDF) was contacted and they supplied a full copy of the investigation. Upon searching the documents supplied by the CDC it was ascertained that the POI, [REDACTED] NP246 had been spoken to by police but not formally after he denied any knowledge of the murder. interviewed A further request has been sent to the Clerk of the Court, Glebe Coroners Court for a copy of the inquest into the murder of Barry</p>
