④ I remember it being very messy, I don't recall my sister telling me why I was there or what had happened.

⑤ At this time I would have been about 16 years old at the time I still lived at home so did Sharmalie.

⑥ I don't ever remember Sharmalie speaking about a relationship or a boyfriend.

- ⑦ I have not spoken with my sister about what I saw at the door. ~~since~~<sup>as</sup> I have never spoken to police before today about what I saw.
- ⑧ The name Peter BAUMANN does not sound familiar.
- ⑨ I had not heard the name Peter BAUMANN until Constable Jo-Anna Wooderson mentioned it to me.
- ⑩ I do remember once a man being at my house. ~~He~~<sup>When</sup> I said to this man "hi Hitler", this man said to me, "Don't say that". I don't remember what this man looked like, I don't recall if he spoke with an accent. As I have said before this is all new to me, the name mentioned does not sound familiar.
