Further to your radio dated 21 August 1993 reference IP/MP/93/87-3 and further correspondence concerning the missing --BAUMANN-- f/n/s Peter Karl Josef, further details unknown.

Enquiries made developed that the missing person is --BAUMANN-- f/n/s Peter Karl Josef, born 20 April 1957 in Oberkirch. He travelled from Oberkirch to Australia as a tourist in December 1981. The missing person had given his relatives the following private address in 1982: [REDACTED] Cross Street, Waverly, P.O. 2024, South Sydney, tel. [REDACTED]. His sister, Mrs. --BAUMANN-SERR--, last managed to contact the missing person by telephone in September 1983. During subsequent attempts to get in touch with him another male person answered the phone.

As the missing person could neither be contacted by letter nor by phone from September 1983 onwards the family made various attempts on a private basis to locate the missing person.

The fact that --BAUMANN-- is missing was brought to the knowledge of our police services only when questioning --BAUMANN-- f/n/s Franz David and --BAUMANN-SERR-- f/n/s Anna-Christa (the missing person's brother and sister) 23 September 1993. They describe their brother as follows: height: approximately 183 cm, hair: darkblond, eyes: blue, tip of nose slightly notched, size of shoes: 43/44, a burn on right hand thus shortening the right thumb slightly, small part of upper incisor splintered off (broken edge). --BAUMANN-- was circulated as missing person in this country with a view to establishing his whereabouts.

The questions asked in your radio messages will be answered in our dispatch letter which will be forwarded by mail. Thank you for your co-operation.
