His sister, Mrs. --BAUMANN-SZRR--, lest managed to contact the missing person by telephone in September 1983. During subsequent attempts to get in touch with him another male person answered the As the minaing person could naither be contacted by letter nor by phone from September 1983 onwards the family made various attempts on a private basis to locate the missing person. The fact that -- BAUMANN -- is missing was brought to the knowledge of our pol: Bervices only when questioning -- BAUMANN-- f/ns Franz David and -- BAUMANN-SERR-- f/ns Anna-Christa (the missing person's brother and sister) 23 September 1993.
