BACKGROUND:


Peter Karl Josef BAUMANN aka ANN aka MOLTZAN born 20/4/57 lastly of [REDACTED] Cross Street, WAVERLEY was reported to the Missing Persons Unit as a Missing Person on the 27 April 1992. BAUMANN went missing around the latter part of 1983 under suspicious circumstances, and enquiries indicated at the time of his disappearance he was employed by the Australian Broadcasting Corporation.

COMMENT:

I would wish to establish if there is any information pertaining to Mr BAUMANN's employment that might assist in explaining his disappearance. I have been informed by a number of personal friends of BAUMANNs' that Mr Bob GOVER, then employed by the A.B.C. had approached them on behalf of the A.B.C. in an attempt to locate BAUMANN. I believe that this information would be valuable to the enquiry. I also believe that if Police could speak to Mr GOVER, it would assist the enquiry.

RECOMMENDATION:

I would respectfully request that approval might be given to approach the A.B.C. to supply all available information pertaining to this matter.

The conditions which apply to permanent officers of the Commission and which attach to this appointment, should you accept it, are to be found in the Broadcasting and Television Act, the Staff Regulations and the Staff Rules. A provision of the Broadcasting and Television Act is that you may be required to serve a probationary period.

You will be required to contribute to the Superannuation Fund for Commonwealth employees. The basic compulsory contribution is 5% of your salary for which you will receive a retirement pension of 50% of your final annual salary if you retire at age 65 after 30 years of contributory service. Contributory service in excess of 30 years provides a slightly higher pension and conversely, contributory service of less than 30 years or retirement between age 60 and 65 results in a pension of less than 50% being payable. In all circumstances your contributions, accumulated at interest, are refunded in a lump sum at the date of retirement. Alternatively, the lump sum may be converted into a higher percentage pension.

The Broadcasting and Television Act provides for compulsory retirement on attaining 65 years of age. As an alternative to retirement at age 65, the Act provides voluntary retirement on the initiative of the individual at any time between age 60 and 65, with a proviso that the Commission may retire an officer any time after attaining 60 years of age.

I have been in touch since with the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs and determined that you will, in all probability, be granted permanent resident status in Australia.
