Re: Peter Karl Josef BAUMANN (missing person)

I have been given a file from your office regarding the above missing person. The file relates to a request from Interpol Wiesbaden regarding the missing person's property, etc.

Please forward the following message back to this agency for the information of Peter's family.

Since Peter's disappearance, NSW Police have conducted extensive inquiries and obtained statements from a number of people who knew Peter at the time he disappeared. The case is currently being reviewed to decide whether the matter should be referred to the NSW State Coroner for a presumption of death to be determined.

Peter's family have also requested information in relation to property left by Peter, including a piano. From the statements contained within the file, it appears as though Peter's property has been destroyed or lost by various people over the years. The only property ever handed to NSW Police was a guitar and a knife. Both of these items were handed to police in 1993, however, no records of these items can be located. It is a fair assumption that they have been destroyed.

Finally, the NSW Missing Persons Unit is currently completing a program whereby we obtain a DNA sample from the family of a long term missing person and compare this to DNA obtained from all unidentified bodies and remains.
