

ISSUE:

Outstanding Material in Long Term Missing Person Case Peter BAUMANN. E909939200037 relates.

BACKGROUND:

As a result of Operation Firenze, it has been identified that there are a number of items required by the Missing Persons Unit, which could assist in identifying the missing person.

It is the requirement of the investigating Command to obtain these outstanding items. It is the expectation of the State Coroner that all necessary material be obtained in all missing persons cases in a timely manner, without exception. These include current and finalised matters.

COMMENT:

Where enquires are to be made internationally, an i@sk is to be submitted to INTERPOL requesting the collection of material and interview with Next of Kin if required. This includes missing persons who are deemed to be in the country unlawfully.

The information is required to positively identify outstanding missing persons to unidentified bodies, skeletal and other human remains, both in this state and throughout Australia.

The checked boxes below are items and information still required for this missing person case.

A DNA collection instructions sheet has been prepared for your assistance and is attached. Further detailed information is available on the NSWPF intranet at:-Systems/Missing Persons Application/Login/Using DNA.

This information will ensure that the Missing Persons Unit has the most current information available relating to the investigation of the case and will also assist us in liaising with the State Coroner where appropriate.

Where the matter is a current investigation, the current Officer in Charge should be tasked to obtain these items. Where the matter has been finalised, at the Coroners

Court, an experienced Police Officer who is familiar with the case should be tasked to obtain these outstanding items and information.

These matters should be completed within 21 days.

Where there may be a delay in obtaining these items, a status report should be forwarded stating the current position and estimated time to complete the above tasks.

Response to request by Missing Persons Unit for outstanding material in relation to long term missing person Peter BAUMANN, event 909939200037 relates.

BACKGROUND

On the 29th of September 2014 Trim D/2014/308152 was received by the Eastern Suburbs Crime Manager and allocated to Plain Clothes Constable Anderson for attention.

The file relates to the long term missing person Peter BAUMANN.

The Missing Persons Unit requested that investigators obtain the missing person identification form and authority for publicity in relation to Pater BAUMANN.

COMMENT

After reviewing all available documents and intelligence holdings an email was sent to the only known next of kin of the missing person Peter BAUMANN, his sister Anna-Christa Baumann-Serr who resides in Germany. The email requested the completion of Missing Persons forms including the authority for publicity and missing person identification form.

In Anna-Christa Baumann-Serr's reply email she was sceptical about the request as she has already provided the documents requested to the NSWPF previously.

A further email was sent to Anna-Christa Baumann-Serr's in a further attempt to obtain the required documents however no reply email was received.
