EYRAUD stated she spoke with MUSY on the 17/11/2016. During the conversation MUSY stated he was happy to assist Police, he did state he was surprised about the Police investigation as MATTAINI stated "he wanted to die and nobody would found his body". MUSY further stated MATTAINI made suicide attempts before he went missing, because of this MATTAINI's relatives weren't surprised of his disappearance.
