Brief Description			

On Tuesday 4/04/2017 a team meeting was held to discuss the investigation into the disappearance of Gilles MATTAINI. At the time an MAR was received by French authorities. French authorities were notified that NSW Police would not be travelling to France to assist with these inquiries. French authorities were prepared to still obtain a DNA sample from Renee MATTAINI for the purpose of comparison in the event that his skeletal remains are located and obtain MATTAINI's medical and military records (documented previous suicidal ideation/attempt) to assist with the investigation into identifying a cause of death.

On Thursday 6/04/2017 AFP officer Ashley WYGODA contacted DSC CHEBL to advise that he will follow up with French authorities to determine who the case has been assigned to and when they will be carrying out these inquiries.

On Saturday 8/04/2017 French authorities emailed DSC CHEBL stating that Mrs. MATTAINI passed away on 09/03/2017 at the age of 82 years. Her body was cremated according to her last wishes and as such no DNA can be taken.

Due to the latest development no further inquiries can be carried out with regard to the obtaining of this DNA sample for the purposes of testing it against unidentified remains.
