His vehicle was located on the evening of 23.7.89 in Fletcher street Bondi, it had been parked and secured in front of no 24 Fennell street, bondi near Fletcher st. Enquiries made by police to neighbours received a negative result. Enquiries at a later date by friends revealed that he had last been seen by a mate that works at WIN TV Wollongong on Sat 22.7.89 at 2.30am and was heading towards the eastern suburbs. This friend known as Phillip can be contacted on [redacted] Ext 257 at WIN TV Wollongong. A search of the area by POL AFP and Bondi Police on the 24.7.89 of the shore line around the Tamarama area and Bondi police also proved negative. Re AMSN 23 on the 23.7.89 an unidentified deceased found off Dover Heights, Sgt Stephenson of Rose Bay police conveyed Mr ELLIS the friend of Peter Bradley WARREN to Clerk Howard Dever. The ID of the Deceased was not established. The vehicle and keys belonging to Warren were found. Mr Ellis who had been searching for him in the Bondi area. The vehicle was located on the evening of the 23.7.89 the keys of the vehicle the following day around 12pm on the 24.7.89.
