


	About 5.15pm on the 23.7.89 a friend of Mr WARREN, Mr Craig ELLIS of [REDACTED] Redfern ph. [REDACTED] attended Paddington Police Station. He stated that he was concerned for the welfare of his friend warren as he had not been seen since Friday 21.7.89. Enquiries with WIN TV in woollongong revealed that Mr Warren was to have returned to work on Sunday night 23.7.89. However he had not done so and had not contacted the TV station to let them know. Mr Warren's vehicle was subsequently found locked and parked in Kennethst, Bondi however enquiries with residents of the street produced a negative result. Keys belonging to Warren were then discovered on the rocks near the water line, a search was made by POL Air and Bondi 1 of the surrounding coast line, again with a negative result.	Sgt CARL water police informed search of area where vehicle and keys located, to be conducted by launch until darkness.  Extensive search by Police Launch Negative result.
