CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

ISSUE

Disappearance of Ross Bradley WARREN, 25 old, from Mackenzies Point, Bondi on 21 July, 1989.

BACKGROUND:

Afternoon of 21 July, 1989 WARREN, newsreader for WIN4, left Wollongong and drove to Sydney. He left a male friend's place at Redfern about 11.15pm that night. He attended bars in the Oxford Street area and was last seen about 2.30am Saturday, 22 July, 1989. His car was located in Kenneth Street, South Bondi near Marks Park, Mackenzies Point. On 24 July, 1989 his keys were located on a rock ledge near the water level below the cliffs at Mackenzies Point. No real evidence of depression. Night of disappearance weather conditions were poor and seas were rough. WARREN has not been located to date, nor any contact whatsoever since 21 July, 1989.

CURRENT:

Youth Worker 187 at Keelong Detention Centre indicated on 21 March, 1991 that NP16 (co-offender in murder of Norman JOHNSON) confided in 186 and another inmate that he had pushed "a poofter off a cliff at Bondi onto the rocks". On 2.4.91 186 corroborated 187 and added that NP16 said "We are always going out bashing fags". On 11.4.91 186 had further conversation with NP16. Although NP16 did not mention killing anybody, again indicated that he and others including NP15 had been bashing homosexuals for a long time in the Bondi area.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

186 still assisting. Inquiries continuing. ESSENTIAL 186 NAME NOT DISCLOSED.
