Missing Person, Ross WARREN, report taken by Constable D ROBINSON on the 24.7.89. Netmail Reference:

Since Ross Bradley WARREN disappearance of the 24.7.89 extensive enquiries have been made. At this time all these enquiries have proved negative.

On the anniversary of his disappearance one year later an anonymous call was made to Wollongong Police station and information was received that Warren was alive and well and living in South Australia. The caller also stated that he was living with a man by the name of 188.

Enquiries were made and revealed that a man by that name had received a traffic infringement notice on the 19.6.90 in the Woilongong area and that this person came from Western Australia. Enquiries were made via NetMail to the Western Australian Criminal Investigation Branch and the person with this name was interviewed in relation to this. He informed Police that he had not been to N.S.W for the last two years.

Enquiries were also made with the South Australian Criminal Investigation unit and to this date those enquiries have also proved negative as to the whereabouts of Ross Bradley WARREN.

At this present time Ross Bradley WARREN is still considered missing and will remain so until further if any information comes to light.
