ISSUE:

Ross Bradley WARREN - reported missing 22 July, 1989. Correspondence from mother, Mrs Kay WARREN, requesting updated information as to progress of enquiries.

BACKGROUND:

See attached papers and case C18145901.

COMMENT:

Examination of documents available show that former Det Sgt BOWDITCH and D/S/Con SHARROCK of the Paddington Patrol had carriage of a missing person enquiry relative to Ross Bradley WARREN.

This matter was subsequently re-investigated by Det Sgt MURDOCH of the Homicide Unit, M.C.S.S in relation to information he received that [1409] was responsible for WARREN disappearing. This allegation was disproved when records showed that [1409] was overseas at the time of the disappearance.

John GIBSON, Senior Prosecutor, Glebe Coroners Court was spoken to in relation to this matter and he stated that the Coroners Office has not been made aware of a request of relatives for an inquest.

GIBSON states that a P79a is required to be submitted, including details that an inquest is requested by relatives and the matter will proceed in the normal manner.

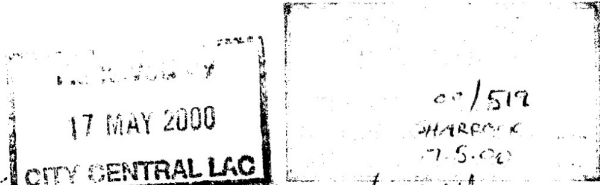
There are no investigators attached to the Rose Bay L.A.C that have any knowledge of this matter, and as Det SHARROCK was involved in the preliminary enquiries it is most appropriate for him to have carriage of this matter.

C18145901 was transferred to City Central LAC this date, and these documents should be forwarded by hand to that command.
