

## Statement of Det BOURIS

**Product Type:** TEXT DOCUMENTS:Statement

**Completed Date:** 10 Jul 2001

**Brief Description:** Det BOURIS in 1989 was performing general duties policing at Bondi. He establishes that the notebook he was issued on 24/07/1989 has since been destroyed. BOURIS states that he attended Kenneth Street, Bondi, and he saw motor vehicle NZC783. He is later shown keys at the base of a rock platform and takes possession of the keys. He outlines property found in the vehicle which was recorded in miscellaneous property receipt A150422.

**Summary:**

**Para 3:** On 24/07/1989 Det BOURIS is performing general duties at Bondi Police Station. He establishes his notebook for this period has since been destroyed.

**Para 4:** Examines a copy of miscellaneous property A150422 and recognises his handwriting.

**Para 7:** Recalls attending Kenneth St and seeing vehicle NZC783. Recalls being shown keys at base of rock platform and taking possession of those keys.

**Para 10:** Later books up property from the incident including wallet (and \$77.31), key ring with eight keys.

1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.
2. I am 32 years of age.
3. On Monday 24 July 1989 I was attached to Bondi Police Station where I performed general duties policing. On Monday 30 April 2001 I spoke with Detective Sergeant PAGE in relation to this matter. I later contacted administration staff at Bondi Police Station in relation to my official notebook for Monday 24 July 1989. I was informed that the notebook has been destroyed.
4. On 20 June 2001 I attended Paddington Police Station and spoke with Detective Sergeant PAGE. Detective PAGE handed me a copy of NSW Police Department Miscellaneous Property Receipt number A150422, that consisted of Part "B" and "C". I identified my handwriting on Part "B" and my signature on the bottom left hand side of the page, dated 24/7/89. I also identified my handwriting on Part "C" up to and including section, "where property stored". I have marked these two pages Annexure "A"

5. I was also shown a video of news footage in relation to this matter.
6. I later attended Bondi Police Station and made further inquiries with administration staff in relation to my official notebook for the 24 July 1989. My "Police Notebook Record Card" for Bondi Police Station was located and I saw that the notebook number F63043 for the 24 July 1989 was destroyed in November 1999. I made a copy of this card consisting of two pages. (Annexure "B")

7. In relation to this matter I recall attending Kenneth Street, Bondi where I saw motor vehicle registration NZC-783 a brown coloured Nissan Pulsar. I recall speaking to persons at that location and being shown an area of bushes and rocks on the southern side of Kenneth Street. I recall being shown the set of eight keys on a rock platform at the base of the cliff and taking possession of those keys.
8. I can not recall if another person or I located the wallet and its contents in vehicle NZC-783.
9. I entered the all the property and the vehicle into NSW Police Department Miscellaneous Property Receipt number A150422, that consisted of Part "B" and "C".
