



1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
2. I am 32 years of age.
3. I am currently attached to the Missing Persons Unit, located the Ferguson Centre, Level six, 130 George Street, Parramatta. My duties include providing assistance to Local Area Commands with the investigation of missing persons.
4. A file is held at the Missing Persons Unit in relation to Ross Bradley Warren. This file contains all information held at this unit concerning the Missing Person which includes records of checks with external agencies and correspondence between Police units. There is only one statement held concerning Ross Bradley WARREN. This statement is by Joanne Williams, formerly attached to the Missing Persons Unit and is dated 19 June, 2001. There is no brief of evidence concerning the missing person held at the Missing Persons Unit.
