

Hi Chris,

This is a suitable sample to do a familial search against all of the unknown deceased samples on the NSW database. We just need authorisation for this. This is NOT under the official DNA Familial Searching Policy as it is a volunteer sample (mother) to be searched against all unknown deceased samples. We have done this before so I am happy for you to authorise this.
