About 10.13am on Thursday 23 November, 1989, I spoke to Sergeant Ingleby in Fletcher street and told him what I had seen.

7. At the time I found the body, I could see no other person down in or about that rock or Bay area. When I commenced to walk down the rock steps there were two people on the concrete walkway but no person around the rock area at water level. I think the tide was on the low ebe.
