1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable for prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.

2. I am 29 years of age.

3. About 10.30am on Monday the 18th of June, 2001, at the Paddington Police Station I obtained a cardboard box which was sealed with a lid and secured in the exhibit system as item 19/C507290.

4. I then travelled to the Department of Analytical Laboratories at Lidcombe. Between the time of receipt at Paddington Police Station and delivery to the Department of Analytical Laboratories I retained control and possession of the cardboard box. At the Department of Analytical Laboratories I spoke with Ms BROWN and I handed to her a Specimen Exhibit Form and that cardboard box.

5. Ms BROWN signed the specimen exhibit form and endorsed the form with a sticker with the reference number FS01/1971. Ms BROWN then handed me a copy of that form.
