1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness.


The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable for prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.

2. I am 53 years of age.

3. Further to the previous statement I have made in relation to the death of John RUSSELL on 26th of February, 1990.

4. I recall that when I attended the scene of RUSSELL's death on 23 November 1989, I noted hair on the hand of the deceased. I clearly recall there were two police from the Scientific Section that attended the incident, and I recall them placing this hair into a bag. I think the bag was plastic. At the time of the inquest into the death of RUSSELL, I became aware that the hair was missing. I was unable to attend the inquest as I had commitments at another court.

5. I later obtained a statement from [DM] in relation to an incident where a gang of youths tried to push him from a cliff near Marks Park, Tamarama. I recall some time later (and possibly the 24th of February 1990) I was approached by Constable Patrick GLEESON who informed me that the group known locally as the Bondi Boys were in the beachfront park. I contacted [DM] and with Constable GLEESON and other police we attended the park and [DM] was in a position to view the group. He did not identify any offenders involved in the incident, however, he appeared nervous.

6. To complete this section of the statement, I am relying on official police notebook F63108 at the rear of Page 63 and notebook F65766 at page 1 and Police Information report 890700154 at Bondi (station reference 89/3309)

(a) At 12.17am on Saturday the 9th of December, 1989, I was on the footbridge which runs from Campbell Parade into Bondi Park and I spoke with [NP146] born [REDACTED], [NP108] born [REDACTED], [NP92] born [REDACTED], [NP79] born [REDACTED] and [NP113] born [REDACTED].

(b) At 4.45am that date, I was on the footbridge which is opposite Bondi Hotel, and I spoke with [NP87] born [REDACTED]

7. Also recorded in the police incident report is the following persons spoken to at 4.45am, which include [NP143] born [REDACTED], [NP150] born [REDACTED], in addition to [NP113] [NP92] and [NP91]

7. Also recorded in the police incident report is the following persons spoken to at 4.45am, which include [NP143] born [redacted] [NP150] born [redacted], in addition to [NP113], [NP92] and [NP91]

8. The names of persons listed in this statement were obtained in my notebook, however, particulars obtained from other police were entered onto the Police Incident Report. Those other individuals included [NP91] born [redacted], [NP43] born [redacted], [NP94] born [redacted], [NP112] born [redacted], [NP93] born [redacted] and [NP107] born [redacted].

9. Shortly after 4.45am that date I have spoken with some witnesses by the name of Angelo PAPAGELOU, Kathy SKARAMANGOS and Evan SOKIALIDIS and I received information that the group I have described in paragraph 6 (a) were present during the robbery.

10. On the 30th of August 1990 I had [DM] view a photograph folder at the Bondi Police Station. [DM] indicated photographs of [NP96] born [redacted] as "very similar" as suspect 2, and, [NP48] born [redacted] as having "similar hair" to a suspect.
