About 11pm on 6.9.86 [redacted] was found by her 87 year old mother in the rear room of her home at [redacted], Haberfield. She had been bashed about the head and a piece of electric cord was wrapped around her head. Numerous blood splash patterns on surrounding walls and objects indicated she had been struck on the forehead about 90cm inside the door leading into the garage. Spray patterns were also found on the garage side of the door and on the refrigerator in the garage. Several small drops located on the wall on the southern side of the garage and on the rear patio leading to the rear yard. It is desired to have these samples analysed to see if they match the victims blood type or if the offender was injured during the attack.
