### Record Exhibit – Prohibited Drug

On (time and date), you attend the Goulburn TAB where you speak to an employee in relation to a report of a male person seen in Keeling Park remove a bag containing white powder from his shirt pocket. You attend the park and approach a male person matching the description as given by the TAB employee. You observe the male person try to hide something in his shirt pocket. You question the male person who denies being in possession of drugs. After searching the POI you locate a clear resealable satchel of white powder. You arrest the POI and take him back to the station where he is charged with possession of a prohibited drug.

NOTE:

Analysis of drug samples is required to identify the presence and quantity of illicit drugs. The Department of Analytical Laboratories (DAL) is the primary forensic service provider to the NSW Police Force. Illicit drug identification is a service provided by DAL.

Until the release of the EFIMS Forensic Analysis Jobs component, the current practices for forensic work will continue. For illicit drug identification by DAL, complete the P377A Drug Examination form (and P377A1 Drug Examination Continuation form if required) to submit along with your exhibit.

When the exhibit is transferred to the forensic service provider, the exhibit will be checked out by the Exhibit Officer/Supervisor using the EFIMS 'Check Out' transaction. The transporting officer must enter their Domain (Windows) password to validate the transaction.

When the EFIMS Forensic Analysis Jobs component is released (late 2011), the request for the illicit drug identification will be created in EFIMS and officers will be required to print the EFIMS Forensic Analysis Request form to submit with the exhibit.

**Event Narrative:** 

The accused, Peter Sodan, went to Dimmey's Pty Ltd Store, 174 Auburn Street, Goulburn. The accused was seen by the Loss Prevention Officer walking around examining articles for sale. The Loss Prevention Officer saw the accused select a compact disc from a display rack which he examined for a short time then placed it in a nylon backpack the accused was carrying. The accused then walked to the watch section where the Loss Prevention Officer saw him select a watch from the display rack which he examined for a short time before placing it in the nylon backpack. The accused then walked quickly to the main exit and out the store, making no attempt to pay for the items. The Loss Prevention Officer followed the accused and approached him in Auburn Street. The Loss Prevention Officer questioned him about the property and the accused said "I must have forgotten to pay. I am sorry. Could I please pay for them now?" The Loss Prevention Officer said, "You are under arrest. Would you please come with me to the Security Office, I am going to contact the Police". Police attended Dimmey's Store and spoke with the Loss Prevention Officer. Police cautioned and put the allegation of the stealing to the accused. Police searched the backpack and located one Sony Brand Compact Disc titled Dirt Track Cowboy by Adam Brand with Dimmey's price tag attached at \$24.95. One Casio brand Digital wrist watch, price tag attached at \$74.95. The property was photographed and returned to the store.
