1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. I am 50 years of age.

3. On the night of 10 January, 1992, I was rostered for duty as the Sydney District Night Supervisor, from 10pm to 6.30am.

4. At about 3.15am on 11 January, 1992, I attended the Redfern Police Station where I had a conversation with Detectives Morland and Thomas and Sergeant Norden the Redfern Supervisor.

5. At about 3.30am the same date I attended the intersection of Holden and Eveleigh Streets, Redfern, where the badly injured Robert Malcolm had been located in a derelict house on the corner of those streets. At this stage the badly injured person had been conveyed to the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital by ambulance. There I saw Detectives Morland and Thomas interviewing three Aboriginal persons. 


