Upon return to the Police Station I had a conversation with him in respect to the Warrant matters. A short time later Detectives Saunders and Phillips arrived at the Station and I said to the Defendant, " These men are Detective Sergeants Saunders and Phillips from Redfern Police Station." Detective Phillips said, " Can you come into this office with us." Indicating the front Office. The Defendant said, " Yeah." He then accompanied them into that office.

- A short time later Detective Phillips came into 6. the side office and told me something. I then went into the front office and Detective Phillips said to the Defendant, "As you requested, I've asked Sergeant Martlew to sit in on the interview, is that O.K. with you?" 

when will the kide be here." I said, "Shortly, after that we will be going to Dubbo." He said, "Will you make sure that my Uncle knows, also me mother so that my sister can get back to Sydney." I said, "Yes I will make some phone calls as soon as Constable Tattersall returns. A short time later the Defendant's children arrived and I had a conversation with his Sister and escorted her and the children into the front office to see the Defendant.

- 10. Some short time later the Defendant was escorted to Dubbo Police Station and lodged in the cells at that Station.
- 11. Whilst the Defendant was in my presence I could not detect the smell of intoxicating liquor on his breath and he appeared to be in a relaxed state. He was dressed in casual clothing consisting of a yellow T Shirt, dark coloured stone washed jeans, white socks and white sneakers.
