4. On Wednesday 6 May, 1992 at about 9am I saw the defendant Kirk PHILLIPS outside the Commonwealth Bank in Redfern Street, Redfern.
5. I approached the defendant and I said,

He said, "Yeah I know the D's come around looking for me at home yesterday."


