> defendant, "Do you wish to take part in an electronic Record of Interview. You are not obliged to take part in an interview unless you wish to do so but whatever interview you make will later be used as evidence. Do you understand that ? " He said, " No. " Detective STARR, " Do you wish to go on the video to decline the offer of an electronic interview ? " The defendant said, " No. I'll see my solicitor. " Detective STARR said, Do you wish to make a handwritten statement about this matter ? " The defendant said, " No. If Kirk has done this to me he's a fucking dog. " Detective STARR said, " Do you wish to read the notes I have made ? " The defendant said, " Yes. " Detective STARR then handed his Police notebook to the defendant who appeared to read the entry.
