I am a legally qualified Medical Practitioner and I am a Neurosurgeon employed by the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital.

My qualifications are: a) Bachelor of Medicine
b) Bachelor of Surgery,
c) Doctor of Medicine,
d) Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of surgeons.

On the morning of 11th January, 1992 at approximately 7.30am in the Neurosurgery Intensive Care Unit of the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, I made a physical examination of the patient known to me as ROBBERT HART MALCOLM.

The result of that examination was as follows:-

Deeply comatose initially flexing to pain but deteriorating by 1200 hours to be extending to pain. He required ventilatory support. He had no pupillary reaction on the right. His temperature was 32 degrees C despite attempted at warming (consistent with a long period of exposure to the elements before resuscitation). He had multiple facial bruising and CT scan demonstrated multiple skull and facial fractures including fracture involving the optic canal on the right.
