1. I am 24 years of age.
2. About 7.10pm on the 29th of January, 1992, I went to bed 49 of Ward E7 South, as a routine check on patient Robert MALCOLM. He appeared to be deceased. I checked his breathing. I called another of the Nursing staff in, Fiona CAPSTICK and she informed Dr. Anne BRADY.
3. The patient had been in Hospital as a result of injuries received from an assault. I had been looking after him for a couple of weeks. I came in at 6.00pm on the 29th of January, 1992, and gave him morphine, and at 6.30pm I also checked, and he was alive. I would have checked after that you tend to just pop in. When I found the body at 7.10pm I couldn't say how long he had been dead, about 10 to 15 minutes at a wild guess. He was cold to the touch before.
