1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in Court as a witness.
2. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I made it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 3 I am 82 years of age.
4. On Monday 13 January, 1992, I was having a drink in the Terrace Bar at the Hotel MENZIES at Wynyard Railway Station. About 7.20pm in company of a man called Roman I spoke with Detective BULLOCK who showed me a photograph of a man who I know as Bob, it was a photograph taken at a social function.
5. On Friday 10 January, 1992, about 8 to 8.30pm in the Punt and Pint Bar at the Hotel MENZIES. I was in the bar drinking with a man called George and Bob came up to us and said to George,

George didn't reply and Bob wanted to buy me a drink
but I refused because I was about to leave.

I have never really had a drink with Bob, I would see him at the bar and he would always go out of his way to say hello. Bob was always a very friendly fellow.
