

REQUEST BY DETECTIVE YANNAKIS OF REDFERN POLICE STATION TO CRIME STOPPERS, NEW SOUTH WALES POLICE RE: INFORMATION SOUGHT CONCERNING THE MURDER OF ROBERT HART MALCOLM.

About 2.05am on Saturday, 110192, the deceased Robert Hart MALCOLM was found unconscious in a derelict house on the corner of Eveleigh Street and Holden Street at Redfern by a number of young male Aborigines. He was found to be suffering massive head injuries consistent with being struck by a heavy weapon, (E.G: such as a baseball bat, brick, timber etc) whilst he was laying on the ground. He died on Wednesday, 29 January, 1992 at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital without regaining consciousness.

Inquiries have revealed the deceased is employed by the G.P.O. Sydney as a salaries clerk and on the evening of the 100192 he had gone to the Menzies Hotel as was his usual practice with a number of workmates. He remained there drinking alcohol and was last seen there in an intoxicated state between 8.00pm and 8.30pm.

Police believe he was later seen by a number of witnesses in the Eveleigh Street area in Redfern by a number of residents in company with an Aboriginal male.

Information is urgently sought by persons residing in the area or persons who may have been passing through Lawson Street between 9.00pm on Friday 100192 and 2.00am the following morning.

The deceased is described as being - Male, Australian, 180cm tall, 41 old, medium to solid build with paunch stomach, medium straight collar length brown colored hair and a bushy moustache. He was wearing a pair of grey trousers, a white long sleeve shirt.
