3. I am 30 years old.


4. On the 23rd December 1993 Dr J. Gubbay who no longer works at St Vincent's Hospital, attended to a male patient, identified as "Harry Unknown" on admission and since identified as Crispin DYE, following an alleged assault. I am the Deputy Director of Medical Services and I am writing this on his behalf.

5. On admission the patient was suffering from a major head injury.


6. The injuries sustained were:-
 - Massive head injury
 - Brain injury with petechial haemorrhages
 - Facial fracture
 - Cardiac arrest
 - He had a blood alcohol level of 0.27.

7. The treatment required was:-
 - Cardiac resuscitation
 - Intubation, ventilation

8. From the date of admission the patients condition remained stable. He was transferred to St George Hospital on 23rd December 1993.
