On 28/12/93 Collin DORRINGTON, Ph: [REDACTED], rang Surry Hills Detectives and states;

DYE came to his work address about 10 days ago when he first arrived in Sydney. DYE informed DORRINGTON that he had been to his mothers place first and informed her about his being homosexual. DYE informed DORRINGTON that his mother had not taken the news well and DYE asked to stay at DORRINGTON's home. Not long after this whilst at DORRINGTON's home the deceased and his mother spoke on the telephone and the deceased was invited back home.

DORRINGTON further states that about 5.00pm on 22/12/93 the deceased telephoned him to try and arrange to go out for drinks but finally no arrangements were made.

DORRINGTON further states that the deceased is attracted to males of an islander appearance and he has friends in the Aboriginal Dance Company. Also that the deceased is a friend of a man called Patrick who is Torres Strait Islander.

DORRINGTON further stated that was DYE was fairly drunk and had seen a cute islander looking male he probably would've gone with him.

DORRINGTON contacted Surry Hills Police on 29/12/93 and informs us that he is going to Hawaii on Friday the 31/12/93 for 10 days.
