He is a native from the Philippines and he arrived in Australia in September 1990. He is a Permanent Resident and he has not applied for Australian citizenship. He moved to Australia as his parents wanted him to join them. His aunty, [1328] sponsored him to come to Australia. [1328] is currently in the

 [NP221] shown wallet. [NP221] identifies wallet as being the one that he lost. It was [I320]'s wallet, he gave it to [NP221] when [NP221] was living at his place. [I320]'s full name is [I320]. [NP221] is not sure when [I320] gave the wallet to him. [NP221] thought that someone stole the wallet when he was working at McDonalds. On his meal break [NP221] took the coins out of the wallet and he may have left the wallet on the Production bin or he may have left the wallet on the front counter. He told the store manager Chris DAVIS about the wallet missing. It was convenient for [NP221] to loose his passport as he did not want to go overseas with a person that wanted [NP221] to travel with him. [NP221] did not report the loss of the passport.

Questions regarding [NP221]'s movements on 22/12/1993 and 23/12/1993.

[NP221] was at his mother's place at Belmont on that date. He spent Christmas day at his mother's home.

On the 23/12/1993 [NP221] may have been working or he may have been at his mother's home at Belmont.

[NP221] then informed by Det Sgt MULHERIN that at 5.01pm on 22/12/1993 \$170 was withdrawn from [NP221] St George account at the Pitt and Market Street branch, city.

[NP221] stated that he must have made a withdrawal on that date. [NP221] believes that on that night he stayed at [NP222]'s (a McDonald manager) home and on the following morning he caught a train and bus to Belmont.

Det Sgt MULHERIN informed [NP221] that records show that he worked at McDonalds restaurant from 11.30am to 8.30pm on 23/12/1993. [NP221] stated that he must have been in Sydney and worked that shift. At that time [NP221] was staying at [NP224]'s address at [REDACTED],

Leichardt. [NP224]'s sister, [I332], was also living there. [NP222] was in Bali on a cruise at that time. [NP222] left Sydney one week before Christmas and returned on 28/12/1993. [NP224]'s telephone number is [REDACTED]. [NP221] caught the bus to work on 23/12/1993.

[NP221] lived at [REDACTED], Daceyville from mid 1992 to mid 1993. He then left that address and went to Belmont where he undertook a T.A.F.E. course. At Daceyville he was sharing the house with [I333] (whose name the telephone account was in), Rosemarie (surname not known) and Rosemarie's boyfriend (cannot recall name). Rosemarie and her boyfriend are also Filipino. The boyfriend owned a brown/dark gold coloured [REDACTED]. The electricity account was in the name of the
