14 December 1998	<p>The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions responded to the NSW Police's request for advice regarding the death of Mr Crispin Dye. The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions advised that Richard William Leonard should be charged with the following offences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Murder ii) Maliciously inflict grievous bodily harm <p>The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions also advised that NP129 should be charged with the following offences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Accessory after the fact to maliciously inflict grievous bodily harm ii) Conceal serious indictable offence <p>Two requisitions were raised for further police investigation.</p>
21 January 1999	<p>The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions wrote to NSW Police in relation to charges against Mr Richard William Leonard and NP129 and raised a further requisition in relation to any medical evidence of a link between Mr Dye's cause of death and head injuries and/or cardiac arrest.</p>
8 February 2001	<p>The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions wrote to NSW Police advising that after careful consideration no charges should be laid against Richard William Leonard and NP129 in relation to the death of Mr Crispin Dye.</p>
