On the 21/07/1999 Stephen LEONARD, the father of the P.O.I. Richard LEONARD, was interviewed at his Cromer home. Mr LEONARD was spoken to about a conversation he had with Detective Sergeant MULHERIN at Dee Why Police Station on the 01/03/1994. Mr LEONARD stated that he now has no clear recollection of conversations he had with his son during the relevant period of time. He stated he son appeared to be effected by drugs during this period and would continually talk in a 'raving' fashion. Mr LEONARD stated that his son's former defacto and co-accused in the murder of BAHMAD, 1126 is now living in New Zealand.
