LIVER	Routine screening tests for poisons were negative.
STOMACH AND CONTENTS	Weight of exhibit: 345g A tablet was removed from stomach and found to contain acetyl salicylic acid.
BLOOD (Preservatives added)	Approximate volume of specimen: 8mL Alcohol: 0.181g per 100mL of blood.
BLOOD (Unpreservatised)	Radioimmunoassay for morphine was negative.

Examination of the remaining specimens of biological fluids yielded no significant results.
