I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of it is untrue to my knowledge I may be liable to punishment.

I am single woman, a Nursing Sister by occupation and I am currently employed as a Relieving Administrator with the [REDACTED].

I have two brothers, Stuart and William and one sister who resides in England.

Before last Thursday, the 22nd December, 1988, I hadn't seen my brother Bill since January, this year but during this period I spoke to him over the phone when I rang him about every four to six weeks. Bill was a school teacher up until about 18 months ago when he went on Sick Leave. He suffered from high blood pressure and stress. About March, 1985 he moved from his Newtown address to his current address at [REDACTED] Newton Street, Alexandria. My brother Stuart lived there up until that time when he sold the house to Bill.

I last saw Bill on Thursday the 22nd December, 1988, about 11.30am when he arrived at my home by train. He stayed about an hour and left to go to the Dentist for his appointment. He sounded normal, happy and well. He made no mention of his personal life. I had a suspicion that Bill was a bi-sexual.

I do know a number of Bill's friends and one is a man known only to me as Robert. He worked with Bill as a school teacher but he retired last year for health reasons. I would describe Robert as being about 48 old, short with a plump build.

On the night of the 29th December, 1988, my brother Stuart did mention to me that Bill had made arrangements to go to his cousins property at Mooney Mooney for a few days. This was to be on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of this week.

I am not aware of any arguments that Bill may have had recently with friends. I am not aware of any enemies that Bill may have had.

I declare that no part of this statement is untrue. I know that it may be used in legal proceedings. It accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared to give in Court if necessary as a witness.
