Brian SAUNDERS attended the Post Mortem. Deceased had a large jaggered wound above his left eye. There was a splinter fracture behind the left eye near the wound. Had a broken jaw. Fractured ribs. Bruising to shin. Bruising to his right wrist and fist. His heart was 80% closed.

Victim's car had two bloodspots on the outside of the car. A white pair of torn shorts were found in the laundry.

At the scene the two park rangers, (statements) already obtained, saw a large amount of blood in the middle of the road near the victim's car.

Dr. Sylvia Hollinger Contacted on 11.189. Informed of witnessess statements. Requested to give cause of death. She stated his brain was bruised at front. Had a swollen upper lip, brusing to the eye area. Had a fractured skull. Had a sub-arachnoid haeemorhage. Bhe said that his head injury was more consistent with a fall. She also stated that he could ve fallen. Injury was originally consistent with falling. She offered opinion that he did not die of a heart attack, but as a result of the fractured skull. She said that she would have to wait the results of his blood alcohol level.

She was not aware of the victim's problems with his skin colour change or his heavy nose bleeds up until the 27th December, 1988, the day before his death. See the statement of the witnesses.

Dr. Hollinger should be made aware of the boyfriend's statement.
