- 1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness.

  The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anyth ing which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 2. I am a Detective Sergeant of police attached to the Crime Scene Unit, Physical Evicence Section and am stationed at the Sydney Police Centre. For the past 23 years my duties have consisted of the technical investigation of serious crime scenes, the collection of exhibits, comparison of toolmarks, shoeprints, resto ration of obliterated markings, latent fingerprints, examination of vehicles, clothing, bodies and the production of photographs, scale plans and exhibits at various courts.
- About 4pm on Thursday 29 December, 1988 I arrived at Newton street, Alexandria, where I spoke to Detective Sergeant Brian SAUNDERS (Redfern), Senior Constable A.P. JONES and Constable 1/c E.N. LITTLER (Crime Scene Unit) and other police. This residence is located on the western side of Newton with the front facing generally East. The residence is an older style timber framed and fibro covered residence of a single ground floor level. There is a small patio at the front. Access to the patio is from theright northern side with the front door to the rersidence at the left or southern side. There is a hallway down the left or southern side. There are two bedrooms at the front of the residence, both are to the north off the hallway. The hallway leads to a loungeroom and there is an opening from the loungeroom that gives access to the kitchen. There is a rear door to the kitchen from the back yard located in the northern side wall. To the rear or west of the kitchen is a door that gives access to the bathroom. The only street access to theback yard is via a wooden gate that is locked and on the northern side of the residence at No give access to the back yard. On its Northern side is the southern wall of the residence at No . The back yard consists of a concrete pathing with a garden area fenced off from the paved area. Off the paved area ran a concrete path to an 'out building' laundry located in the north east corner ESE WILL of the rear yard.



- The residence was furnished in a normal manner and there was no signs 5. of any forced entry or ransacking within the residence. There were dropletts of blood on the floor at the front and rear of the hallway, on the floor and door jamb inside the front bedroom and on the floor at the northern side and foot of the double bed (photo 1-2-). There was blood stained clothing at the northern side of the same double bed near the head of the bed and there was blood stained pillowcase (photo 1-2-). There were blood spots on the floor in the second bedroom at a clothes basket and on the western side of the double bed in that room. There were blood spots on the floor of the loungeroom just inside the hallway door . There were blood spo ts on the lino floor of the kitchen, just inside the opening from the loungeroom (photo 6). There were blood stained towel, glass and cigarettes on the north -ern end of the kitchen sink drainer in the kitchen (photo 8). Squatting over the side of the bath in the bathroom was the body of a deceased male, believed to be a William ALLEN, who resided at Newton Street, Alexandria. The body was dressed only in a white and blue hooped short sleeved shirt. The feet were in the doorway with the knees below the side of the bath. Both arms were in the bath(photo 15). There was a small amount of blood and a blood stained cloth in the bath (photo 15-18-).

- 6. On the wall, window sill of the bathroom window was a small amount of blood(Photo 10-11-). On the concrete beneath the window and chair was an amount of drop spots (Photo 12-). On the top of a bird cage, located to the front (East) of the bathroom window, and standing on the shelf attached to the wall, was a apir of black framed glasses with the left lens missing. There appeared to be smears of blood on the other lens (Photo 13-14-). The body was later removed from the bath and examined. Dr S.HOLLINGER of the Division of Forensic Medicine, Glebe was in attendance and examined the body. There was no severe signs of trauma to the body. There was a wound to the for ehead above the left eyebrow (photo 17).

- 8. On the clothes line in the rear yard were 2 towels. There were blood stains on the light blue towel (photo 20- 21-). The stains appeared to be from the use of the towle as a pad to stop bleeding. There were a number of blood spots on the concreet paving in the back yard and there were spots of the concrete kerbing along the fence with the back garden (Photo 23.) In the laundry, which is an'out building' remote from the residence by about 10m, was a large collection of miscellaneous junk.

In the south east corner of the laundry was a set of concrete tubs. In the left tub were a number of items, including towels (Photo 24). There were blood spots on these items. (Photo 25).

- 11. In reconstruction of the scene at Newton Street, Alexandria, it would appear that the injuries to the deceased occurred elsewhere and that he returned to his home with the injuries. He climbed over the wall/ fence between No and walked up the northern side passageway of No, past the 'on the side' table in the passageway. Entry to No was through the bathroom window, with the resultant blood left on the window and window sill. Blood on the towel on the clothes line and laundry tub was when they were used after the injury was received. Once in the house the deceased walked up the hall, into the bedrooms and left blood spots behind. It appears that the bed in the front bedroom was lain in. Cigarettes were consumed and a glass drunk from and these blood stained items left on the kitchen sink. Some time later something happened and the deceased collapsed and died in the position he was found in.
- 12. About 6.10pm on the same date at the City Morgue, in the presence of Dr Hollinger the head and face of the deceased was cleaned up and a further photograph taken, COPY OF WHICH I NOW PRODUCE: PHOTO 32. HEAD OF WILLIAM EMANUEL ALLEN.
- 13. About 2.30pm on Thursday 2 February, 1989 Constables 1/c M.P.BENDT and J.L.McKINNON (Crime Scene Unit) attended Park Road, Alexandria outside Alexandria Park. Park Road in this area runs generally north and south. At the northern end is Buckland Street which bounds the northern side of Alexandria Park. At the southern end of Park Road is Power Avenue and it bounds the southern side of Alexandria Park. 4 photographs were taken, COPIES OF WHICH I NOW PRODUCE:
