1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

3. I have known Bill Allen for about 20 years, about 5 years ago Bill purchased his house at [REDACTED] Newton Street, Alexandria. he moved in and as far as I knew he lived there alone. I am aware that Bill was homosexual, but I had no idea that he was a Paedophilia until some time after his death.

4. About 3 days after Bill died,(29/12/89) one of my neighbours told me something. (Informed he was dead) About a week after his death [REDACTED] rang me and asked me to give him a hand to move some furniture. A few days later I met him at Bill's house and I gave him a hand to move furniture.

5. A few days later [REDACTED] dropped about 6 recorded video cassettes into my

house. [redacted] said to me, "there are some porno tapes, do you want them." I took the tapes and later I played one of them and found that it contained scenes of men and children having sex. I was revolted by this and I later wiped all of the cassettes, with the exception of one which contained footage of Bill and his friends on holiday.
